**MEYER DARRAGH ATTORNEY HONORED BY THE WOMEN'S BAR
ASSOCIATION OF WESTERN PENNSYLVANIA**

Marie Milie Jones, a partner with Meyer, Darragh, Buckler, Bebenek & Eck, PLLC, is the recipient of the 2010 Susan B. Anthony Award, the most prestigious honor bestowed by the Women's Bar Association of Western Pennsylvania.

The Susan B. Anthony Award is presented annually to an individual who most exemplifies the goals of the Women's Bar Association by demonstrating dedication to encouraging and promoting women in the law and maintaining the highest standards for the legal profession.

Ms. Jones was presented with the award at a reception held by the Women's Bar Association on February 16th at the Omni William Penn.
